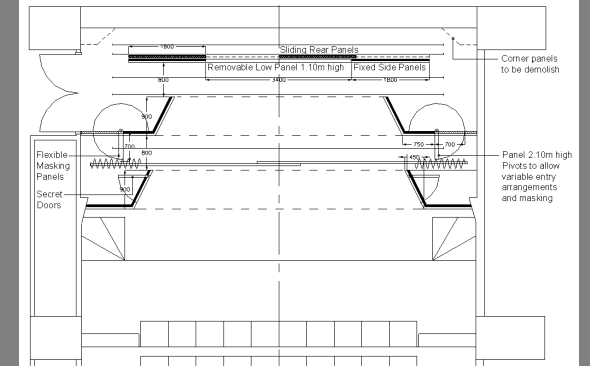




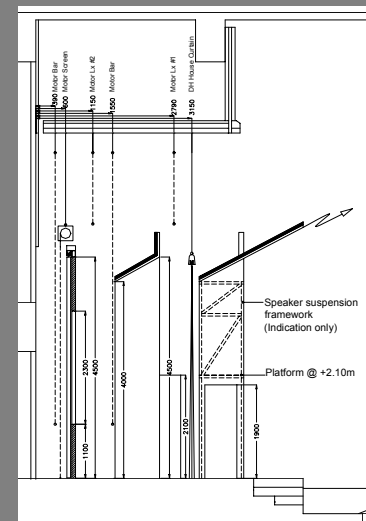

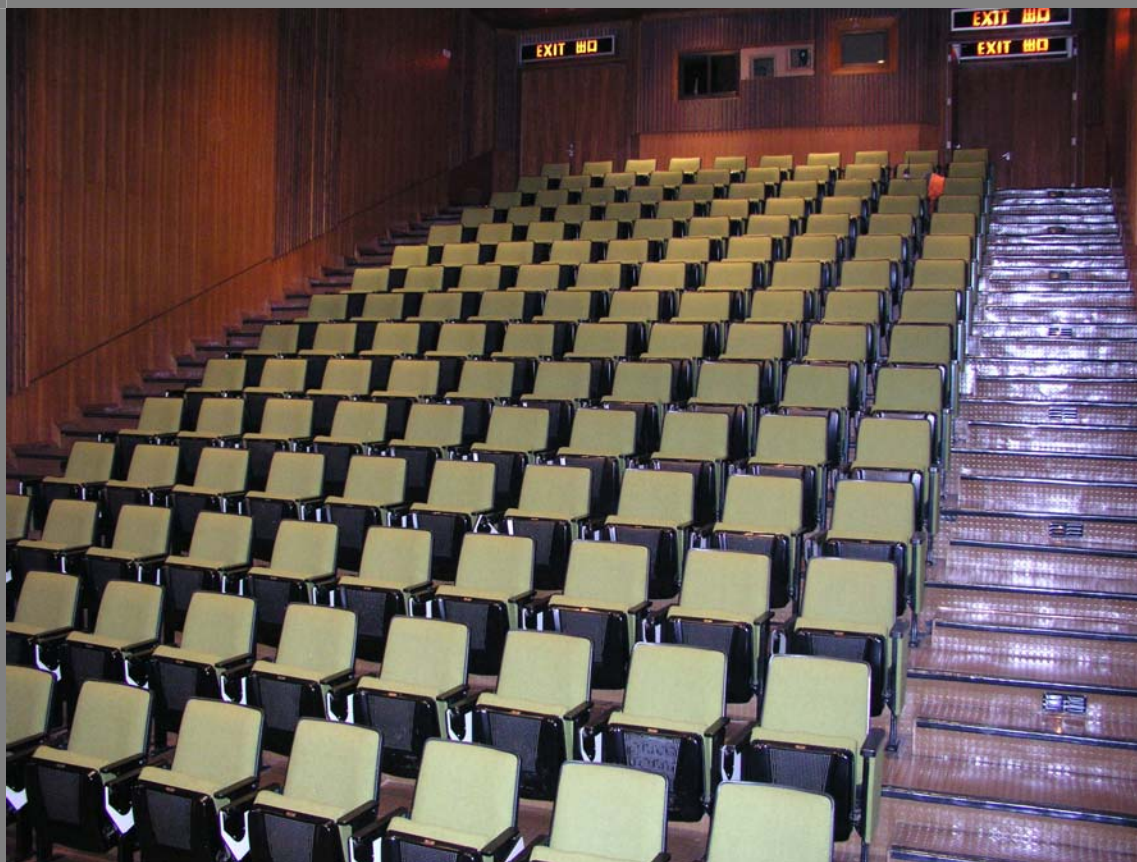

BEFORE RENOVATION

Individual seats had individual writing tablets in keeping with the expected prime function of this venue – as reflected in its name.

The Lecture Hall of Sheung Wan Civic Centre has been refurbished to provide a new look, better audience comfort and the appropriate stage environment for the current performance requirements of its many diverse users.

- In the auditorium, seats, flooring and wall materials have been replaced together with a new ceiling incorporating a correctly sized lighting bridge.
- The stage has been extended to allow the creation of an acoustic enclosure that better serves the music, choral and meeting presentations that form the bulk of bookings for this venue and at the same time to allow a cross-over passage to be formed.
